

Region 1 League Rules

Important Premier and Colonial League Rules, Spring 2010

The three-referee system will be used for all games. Each team is responsible for half the referee game fee. Teams that fail to pay will be fined. The referee fee will be divided equally among the officials:

U13-14 Premier and Colonial League	Total \$120 – each ref \$40
U15-18 Premier and Colonial League	Total \$140 – each ref \$46.50

For U13 through U15 teams, a maximum of eighteen players may be listed on roster. For U16 through U18 teams, a maximum of 22 players may be listed on roster. However, for each game, only 18 players may be listed on the roster submitted to the referee; once the game roster has been submitted to the referee, only the 18 players listed may participate in the match. Every player MUST have a valid and current US Youth Soccer player pass. NO Loan/Guest Players.

Each coach MUST have a copy of his/her team's official stamped State Association Cup roster and US Youth Soccer player passes at every game. A copy of the roster will be given to the referee. The referee is required to check player passes against each player and against the names on the official stamped State Association Cup roster. This is not optional.

The Game Report and a copy of the official state roster from each team will be delivered to the referee prior to kick-off. After the game, the referee shall submit the completed Game Report and both teams' rosters to the appropriate commissioner or administrator.

Red and Yellow Cards. The referee shall immediately forward to the appropriate commissioner details about any red or yellow cards given during the game.

Except as otherwise provided by these rules, FIFA "Laws of the Game" apply.

The length of games and ball size:

U14	35 min halves	Size 5 ball
U15-18	40 min halves	Size 5 ball

Note: Tie scores will stand at the end of regulation time for all preliminary matches.

Substitutions are unlimited and may be made, with the consent of the referee, at any stoppage of play. There is no limit on reentry.

Once a referee has jurisdiction of a game, the game may be terminated only by the referee as provided for in the FIFA "Laws of the Game."

The Region I League's Administration has complete and final authority over any disciplinary matter arising out of the Region I League play including suspension and fines when considered appropriate.
